Icelandic Adventure 4x4

Friday 27th September



Arrival Day

Guests arrive at Rally HQ, Hotel Natura, Reykjavik, collecting their 4x4 hire car en route from the airport, where you will stay for two nights.

Most flights into Iceland arrive late afternoon/early evening therefore, nothing is planned other than arriving and settling into your hotel. You can relax and explore Reykjavik and see the wonders of the Capital as tonight is a free evening.

Saturday 28th September



Set up day

The day begins with trackers and GPS trips being fitted, collection of event packs and your Roadbook.

Lunch is not included so you are free to make your own arrangements. In the afternoon we have included a visit to FlyOver Iceland. An immersive experience where you view Iceland from the sky.

The evening welcome dinner, signifies the beginning of your 4x4 Icelandic Adventure.

Sunday 29th September



Day 1—Reykjavik to Langaholt

A relaxing 9am start as we make our way from Hotel Natura, Reykjavik to tonight's overnight stop at Hotel Langaholt, where we will stay for two nights. Our route today takes us 150 miles past Hvammsvik and through Borgarnes with three regularities planned and, for the Trial entrants, one test. En route we have a visit to the Agricultural Museum at Hvanneyri, for lunch.

A late afternoon finish is planned allowing time for a relaxing drink in the bar prior to dinner.

Monday 30th September



Day 2—Langaholt to Langaholt

Another 9am start, as it will be for the rest of the week, we embark on a circular route of 105 miles on the Snaefellsnes peninsular. Our route along with a few regularities will go via Snaefellsjokull (made famous by Jules Verne), Hellnar, Budir, Olafsvik and Kirkjufell.

A morning coffee stop, and a lunch halt is included as is time to stop and take pictures along the way. Returning late afternoon to our overnight hotel in time for a shower, change and dinner.

Tuesday 1st October



Day 3—Langaholt to Borgarnes

We leave Langaholt behind as we make our way towards Hotel Hamar.

We will experience 155 miles and a couple of regularities and a test today split by morning coffee and lunch. Our route takes us to the Shark Museum at Orlygshofn, as well as Stykkisholmur, and Brattabrekka.

On arrival at Hotel Hamar guests have the hot tub to look forward to as well as the bar and dinner.

Wednesday 2nd October



Day 4— Borgarnes to Fludir

Our regular 9am start sees us leave Hotel Hamar as we head for Hotel Fludir via the Langjokull glacier. If conditions allow, we plan to drive on the glacier. We won't know until the morning when the advance car arrives at the Glacier and checks conditions. So, fingers crossed.

130 miles and just three regularities today as we travel through Thingvellir (site of the Viking Parliament), Geysir and Gullfoss.

Thursday 3rd October



Day 5—Fludir to Reykjavik

The last day! 105 miles back to our start venue as we travel to Reykjavik via Skalholt, Reykholt, Solheimar and the power station at Nesjavellir; with the opportunity for those who wish to get their tyres wet in an Icelandic river - subject to weather conditions.

Arriving back in Reykjavik with time to change for the farewell evening meal.
